

CIRCULAR
BAN ON THE USES OF MOBILE PHONES & OTHER ELECTRONICS GADGETS
IN SCHOOL PREMISES BY THE STUDENTS

Dear Parents,

1. Mobile phone is the most commonly used gadget in today's life irrespective of whether they are students, teachers, professional or others. It is imperative for us to reflect on this over dependence on technological interventions which can have both positive and negative repercussions as overuse of Mobile Phones can result in higher level of depression, anxiety social isolation, hyper activity, hyper tension, sleep loss and poor eye sight. Hence, use of mobile phone needs to be regulated in the school premises.
2. In view of the problem areas as mentioned above & perpetual issues of indiscipline due to these devices Mobile phone, Smartphone, Bluetooth devices, speakers, earphones, headphones cameras or any electronic gadgets/ communication devices are not permitted in school. Hence parents are requested not to allow their children to carry all the above mentioned devices. This measure is to curb distraction & foster a favoured learning environment.
3. Further at home also the students must use phones and all digital equipments responsibly at all times in accordance with law. They must ensure files stored in their possession do not contain violent, degrading or obscene images/ material.
4. Cyber bullying as defined by current legislation is completely unacceptable and is a form of harassment. It is a criminal offence.
5. Students are not allowed to bring Mobile phone, Smartphone, Bluetooth devices, speakers, earphones, headphones, cameras or any electronic gadgets/ communication devices to school. Only Analog watches are allowed. If found, the above mentioned items will be immediately confiscated and the following fines will be imposed.
 - (a) First offence- Fine **Rs 500/-** & release of item after **3 months**.
 - (b) Repeat offence- Fine **Rs 1000/-** & release of item after the **academic year**.
6. No request/ application will be entertained. For strict compliance.
